

Hadley Township currently has a vacancy on the Hadley Township Planning Commission and is seeking candidates for the open Planning Commissioner position. Requirements are that the applicant must be 18 years of age, a resident of Hadley Township and not an employee of the Township. Planning Commissioners should be representative of the community that they serve. This position will be serving the remainder of a three year term which ends in 2024. The Planning Commission meets monthly on the third Tuesday of the month at 7:00pm at the Hadley Township Offices and all Planning Commissioners are expected to attend.

#### Planning Commission Roles and Responsibilities

- Provides community leadership on local planning and development policy.
- Is an appointed body that advises the legislative body on planning matters.
- Preparation of the master plan, which influences the regulations and standards in the zoning ordinance and any future changes to it.
- Is the primary body responsible for approval of Site Plans.
- Commissioners are responsible to ensure that new development fits the community's vision for a given site, with help from professional staff or consultants.
- Responsible for Special Use approvals.
- Is the main forum for discussion of changes to the Zoning Ordinance text and map.
