DISCUSSION ITEMS: COLLECT IDEAS FOR FUTURE TOWNSHIP PROJECTS

**Facilities**

- Old Town Hall: Kitchen floor replacement, tin ceiling, replace drapes, replace paneling, water softener
- Township Office Building: minor maintenance interior/exterior, finish basement for community use, additional parking for one precinct
- Fire Hall: minor maintenance interior/exterior, Historical Building
- Library: no items

**Parks & Recreation**

- Marston Park: Electricity for ballfield, playground equipment, hockey/roller rink, pavilion with restroom, tennis/pickleball courts, octoball, sidewalk to far field, walking trail from Hartwig Park to Marston Park
- Hartwig Park: Electricity to bridge/pavilion, parking/driveway, sidewalk to pavilion, drain low area
- Bike Trail: Hadley Metamora Recreation to town

**Services**

- High speed Internet: expensive look to matching funds or wait to see what Fed/State/County plan will contribute
- Sewers Downtown: needed to improve downtown, market analysis first step, may possibly show an increase in value to downtown properties
- Roads: back up plan, resurface Woodland Dr., Pratt Rd. west
- Sidewalks: maintenance
- Recycling: Hazardous waste

ARPA FUNDS - \$468,000 available, obligate by end of 2024, use by end of 2026

- Discussion led to three projects best suited for use of funds: Sewers downtown, Marston Park, and Old Town Hall remodel
- Another meeting held in 4-8 weeks to discuss rough cost estimates for these three projects
- At next meeting we will discuss ways to get community input via surveys or subsequent meetings
