Based on a recent review completed by the Michigan State Police (MSP), the Lapeer County Road Commission (CRC) is in the process of removing invalid speed zones within your Township. Please provide the following information to anyone within your organization that you feel would benefit from this information.

<u>Summary</u>

In January 2023, the Michigan State Police reviewed the Speed Zones currently in place within the Lapeer CRC's jurisdiction. This review was prompted by State protocol, which requests that every 10 years, the Michigan State Police completes a random sampling of the speed zones. Once they started their review, it became apparent that past Traffic Control Orders (mostly late 1980's to early 2000's) did not follow the correct format for the Speed Zone paperwork.

The zones identified having incorrect paperwork were deemed invalid and <u>must be removed</u>. A new speed study may not be requested until after the signs have been removed for a <u>minimum</u> of 90 days.

Based on the MSP findings, 30 zones (county-wide) were found to be invalid. Within Hadley Township, the zones identified for removal are:

- Fox Lake Road 45 mph Honert Road and Hadley Road
- Pratt Road 25 mph west and east of Hadley Road
- Hadley Road 25 mph south and north of Pratt Road
- Hadley Road 35 mph 1,750-ft to 3,000-ft south of Pratt Road

- A county map of the zones being removed vs. the zones staying in place (color coded by speed)
- A county-wide list of the road names and zone limits being removed
