



Election Mailings for 2024

There are several items being mailed to voters in the next few weeks regarding changes that went in effect because of the approved ballot proposals from November of 2022.

ELECTION MAIL TO KEEP FOR REFERENCE

➤ **All Hadley Township voters will receive:**

- a postcard notifying you of new early voting in-person sites.

➤ **Precinct 2 voters will receive:**

- a new ID card notifying them of the permanent change in their precinct number and location for voting.
- **All** Hadley Township voters will now vote at the Township Offices at 4293 Pratt Rd. which is Precinct 1.

ELECTION MAIL TO BE RETURNED TO HADLEY TOWNSHIP CLERK'S OFFICE (RETURN POSTAGE IS PREPAID)

➤ **Voters on the Permanent Absent Voter list will receive:**

- Absent voter applications for the February 27, 2024 Presidential Primary.
- Please remember to sign, and mark whether you want to receive a Democratic or Republican ballot.
- Mail or drop off the completed application to the clerk's office

➤ **Voters who are on the Permanent Ballot list will receive:**

- A ballot selection form.
- Since these voters don't receive an absent voter application, they will need to complete this form to tell us which ballot type they would like (Republican/Democratic)
- Mail or drop off the completed ballot selection form to the clerk's office

If you stop by the Township Office after hours, or don't want to get out of your car, there is a new drive-up ballot drop box for you to deposit your applications and absent voter ballots.
