- A. Pursuant to Public Act No. 188 of the Public Acts of 1954 (the Act), the Hadley Township Board established a special assessment district for maintenance of Sandy Drive and the Supervisor has prepared a special assessment roll describing all parcels of land to be assessed, the names of the respective record owners, and the total amount to be assessed against each parcel per year for each of the next five (5) years.
- B. The Hadley Township Board has conducted a Public Hearing to review and consider any objections or comments to the special assessment roll for the maintenance of Sandy Drive for the next five (5) years pursuant to proper notice in compliance with the Act.
- C. The Act provides that, following the public hearing, the Township Board may confirm, amend, or correct the special assessment roll or refer it back to the Supervisor for revision or direct a new roll to be made.
